- In all cases, decisions of the judges are final and will not be open to discussion.
- Absolutely no profanity or insensitive subject matter will be permitted.
- Costumes must be appropriate for all age group's, this is a community event.
- Acts are responsible for their own props and costumes.
- Performances may be screened for appropriateness by the talent show committee.
- If you act requires recorded accompanying music, the music must be provided to the talent show committee 2 weeks prior to the event. The music must be labelled with your name and song name.
- All acts must have written consent from a parent or guardian for each child.
- There will be prizes given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.
